

## Change of the base period and classification according to the kind-of-activity units

Along with the publication of data for January 2024, the Statistical Office of the SR applied changes in the methodology bringing improvements to the short-term monthly sectoral statistics resulting from the European legislation - transition to a new base period (from 2015 to 2021) and the application of the concept of the kind-of-activity units for selected indicators (selected indicators are not automatically classified according to the main activity of the entire enterprise, but according to which activities of the enterprise they originate from).

In the industry sector, the mentioned changes affected several indicators.

Transition to the new base period (from 2015 to 2021):

- **industrial production** (annual indices/monthly, base indices/monthly)

Transition to a new base period (from 2015 to 2021) and application of the concept of the kind-of-activity units for selected indicators:

- **turnover** (year-on-year indices in constant prices, basic indices in current prices/monthly)
- **new orders** (annual and monthly indices at constant prices/basic indices at current prices/monthly)
- **number of hours worked by employees** (basic indices/monthly)
- **wages** (annual indices, base indices/monthly)
- **employment** (annual indices, base indices/monthly)
- **labor productivity from turnover** (year-on-year indices at constant prices/monthly)
- **prices** of domestic industrial producers (basic indices/monthly)

The changes were reflected in the adjustment of indicators in the entire time series in all affected data cubes in the public DATAcube. database.
